- 1. Call to Order & Roll Call Brian Johnson

 Brian Johnson, Chair, called the meeting to order at 12:08 pm. A quorum was present.
- Approval of the Agenda
 A motion to approve the agenda was made by Darwin Lehmann, seconded by Brian
 Johnson. Approved unanimously.
- 3. Approval of Meeting Minutes from 08/31/2022

 A motion to approve the minutes from 8/31/2022 was made by Darwin Lehmann, seconded by Brian Johnson. Approved unanimously.
- 4. Regulatory Update Margaret Buckton & Jon Muller Margaret Buckton shared that no new guidance has been issued from any regulatory authority with regards to this program.
- Market Update Don Krattenmaker & Athena Simpson
 Don Krattenmaker provided an update on the overall natural gas markets, exports, and pricing.
- 6. Participation/Marketing Update Jen Albers & Athena Simpson
 Jen Albers and Athena Simpson shared a marketing report on new participants since the
 last meeting and those actively considering participating. Discussion took place around
 other marketing activities that have taken place since the last meeting, including an
 early renewal option for districts that participated in the program for the full FY 2022
 program year or longer.

7. Approval of Agreements

- Application & Agreements to Join the 28E
- Participation Agreements
 Jen Albers shared the current list of districts that have completed the Application to Join the 28E along with FY 2022 contract amendments and FY 2023 contracts that have been received to date, for approval by the Board.

A motion was made by Darwin Lehmann and seconded by Russ Reiter to approve the pending Applications to Join the 28E as well as the pending Participation Agreements and Amendments for 2021-22 and 2022-23. Approved unanimously.

8. Iowa LGRP Financial Report – *Jen Albers*

- Approval of Final FY 2022 Report from Service Providers
 Final financial reports from the FY 2022 program year were reviewed showing
 participant's contracted v. actual amounts for the LGRP pool as a whole and each
 individual participant. Service provider gross margin is limited by contract to 20% of
 total premiums, which was not exceeded this year so there are no refunds due.
 Discussion ensued. Board Members noted that while there are no refunds due to
 participants for FY 2022, that means school budgets were protected as intended by
 the program.
- Approval of 6/30/2022 Iowa LGRP Financial Report
 Jen Albers shared the revised Financial Report for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2022
 for the Iowa LGRP 28E. The revised financial statements included 3 amendments for
 the FY 2022 program year that occurred during the final review process. A motion
 was made by Darwin Lehmann and seconded by Russ Reiter to approve the revised
 financial report for the fiscal year ended 06/30/2022. Discussion ensued. Approved
 unanimously.
- Update on 06/30/2022 Iowa LGRP Audit
 Jen Albers reported that auditors from Denman & Company have already started
 testing for the FY 2022 year and will finalize their reports now that the final
 amendments are incorporated. They will present the financial report to the Board at
 the January meeting. Going forward, the audit will be conducted after the November
 board meeting and presented in January.
- 9. Other Business/Adjourn

Discussion took place around the idea of offering an optional multi-year agreement to program participants, including pros/cons, process and additional risk fee. Consensus was it could be a good option to have available if districts are interested in planning further into the future. Staff will look into the implications and logistics.

There being no other business, Darwin Lehmann moved to adjourn and Russ Reiter seconded. Approved unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 1:05 pm.
